### Arabic Text:

اللَّهُمَّ اكْفِنِي بِحَلَالِكَ عَنْ حَرَامِكَ، وَأَغْنِنِي بِفَضْلِكَ عَمَّنْ سِوَاكَ

**Transliteration:** *Allahumma akfini bihalalika 'an haramika, wa aghnini bifadlika 'amman siwaka.*

**English Translation:** "O Allah, suffice me with what You have made lawful instead of what You have made unlawful, and enrich me by Your bounty so that I have no need of anyone besides You."

### Urdu Translation:

اے اللہ! مجھے تیرے حلال سے حرام کی طرف نہ جانے دے، اور تیرے فضل سے مجھے سب کے سوا بے نیاز کر دے۔

## The Lexical Blueprint

- **اللَّهُمَّ (Allahumma):** O Allah (An urgent, encompassing call).
- **اكْفِنِي (Akfini):** Suffice me / Protect me (Root: to make enough).
- **بِحَلَالِكَ (Bihalalika):** With Your Lawful (Pure, permitted sustenance).
- **عَنْ حَرَامِكَ (An haramika):** From Your Unlawful (Forbidden earnings/Riba).

- **وَاعْنِينِي (Wa aghnini):** And enrich / Make me independent.
- **بِفَضْلِكَ (Bifadlika):** By Your Grace / Favor.
- **عَمَّنْ سِوَاكَ (Amman siwaka):** From anyone besides You.

## Where Does This Supplication Come From?

This is an authentic Hadith taught by **Ali ibn Abi Talib (R.A)**. He shared it with a debtor, promising that Allah would settle debts even as massive as a mountain. It is officially recorded in **Tirmidhi (3563)** and **Riyad as-Salihin (1486)**, making it a reliable and powerful daily practice.

## The Actionable Wazifa: Digital Sunnah 2026

- **The Pre-Task Trigger:** Before checking your bank balance, stepping into a high-stakes meeting, or starting work, pause and recite this once with intention.
- **The Daily Loop:** Recite the full dua 100 times daily (or 7 times post-Fajr) with 3 Salawat before and after.
- **The Release:** Proceed with your halal hustle, knowing the outcome is already spiritually secured.
