THE SCOPE OF MERCY

One Verse. One Global Mission.

- **Muslims:** Guidance, spiritual elevation, and the path to Paradise.

- **Non-Muslims:** Mercy through justice, ethics, and peaceful existence.

- **Women & Families:** Restoration of honor, rights, and familial compassion.

- **Animals & Nature:** Ethical treatment of all living creatures and stewardship of the Earth.

- **The Sick & Weak:** Comfort, social security, and a reminder of divine reward.

SPIRITUAL HABIT LOOP

Reprogramming the heart through daily remembrance.



TRIGGER

Identify moments of anger, stress, or online negativity.



RECITE

Softly whisper: "*Wa mā arsalnāka illā raḥmatan lil-‘ālamīn.*"



REFLECT

Ask: "How can I embody mercy in this specific situation?"



REWARD

Experience immediate inner calm and divine connection.

FREQUENCY	IDEAL TIME	SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVE
11 Times	After Fajr Prayer	Family peace & daily spiritual protection.
41 Times	Before Maghrib	Relief from anxiety and mental heaviness.
101 Times	Fridays / Weekly	Seeking ease during major life hardships.

Sar Dard Ki Dua

Recite this verse with Surah Waqiah (21:19) for relief from headaches and mental strain.

Safar Ki Dua

Combine this verse with the Sunnah travel dua for divine mercy and safety on the road.
