When to Recite:

Daily Wazifa Routine for Pregnancy & Conception

 - Recite **Surah Al-Ikhlās** (The Purity) 3 times.
 - Recite **Surah Al-Falaq** (The Dawn) once.
 - Recite **Surah An-Nas** (Mankind) once.

4. **Specific Duas:**

- Recite '**Rabbi habli minas saliheen**' 7 times.
- Recite '**Rabbi hab li mil ladunka zurriyyatan tayyibah, innaka samee'ud du'a**' 7 times.

5. **General Supplication:** Make personal dua for a healthy conception, a smooth pregnancy, and a righteous child.

Evening Routine (Before Bedtime):

1. **Durood Shareef:** Recite 10-11 times.

2. **Recitation of Surahs:**

- Recite **Surah Al-Ikhlās** 3 times.
- Recite **Surah Al-Falaq** once.
- Recite **Surah An-Nas** once.

3. **Ayatul Kursi:** Recite once, visualizing protection over yourself and your potential child.

4. **General Supplication:** Make sincere dua for well-being and gratitude.

Additional Practices:
